CURRENT STANDARD TRADING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. All business undertaken by the Company is subject to such one or more of the following Conditions as may be applicable thereto.
2. All ships Agency business undertaken is subject to the Standard Trading Conditions of the Institute of Chartered Shipbrokers (current edition).
3. Any motor launch services contracted on behalf of the Principal could be subject to the United Kingdom Standard Conditions for Towing and Other Services (current edition). The hirer should ascertain whether these conditions apply for the service provided.
4. If goods are lost or damaged when in the possession of the Company or its contractors and it cannot be determined when the event causing the loss or damage occurred, the same shall be deemed to have occurred in warehousing. UK Warehousing Associated current contract conditions for logistics apply to all goods stored or under the control of the Company.
5. The Customer will not seek to impose on any such company a liability greater than that accepted by the Company in accordance with these Conditions.
6. If there is any conflict between these Terms and Conditions and the Customer's Terms and Conditions these Terms and Conditions shall replace or prevail over the Customer's Terms and Conditions.
7. English Law shall apply to any Contract and agreement and these Terms and Conditions shall be constructed and enforced in accordance with English Law.
